
Illinois Depends on **World Markets**

Exports from Illinois helped contribute to the \$2.21 trillion of U.S. goods and services exports in 2016.



Illinois's Top 5 Export Categories (Millions of U.S. Dollars)




Exports Support Jobs

Nationally, U.S. jobs supported by exports reached an estimated 11.5 million in 2015, up 1.9 million from 2009.

A total of 23,252 companies exported from Illinois locations in 2014.






Free Trade Agreements

- The U.S. currently has 14 free trade agreements in force with 20 countries.
- Illinois's exports to U.S.
 FTA partners totaled
 \$32.4 billion in 2016.

In 2016, exports to FTA markets accounted for **54%** of Illinois exports



Since 2006, exports from Illinois to FTA markets have grown by 55%
